

LETTER NAME FLUENCY

Level C Week 1




Have your student practice saying letter names each day. Because our newest readers are still developing their understanding of the way text works, there are dots under the letters. Ask your reader to put a finger on each dot as the letter name above is said. Make sure your child is always going from left to right. Developing these habits now will make learning to read an easier process.

DAY **1**  Ask your child to place a finger on the dot under the letter as the letter name is said. Always move from left to right. Circle all letters said correctly. Then finish the activity for the day. Circle the lowercase letter that matches each capital.



DAY **2** 

Ask your child to place a finger on the dot under the letter as the letter name is said. Circle all letters said correctly. Then finish the day's activity. Circle boxes with matching lowercase and capital letters. Draw an X on boxes that don't match.






