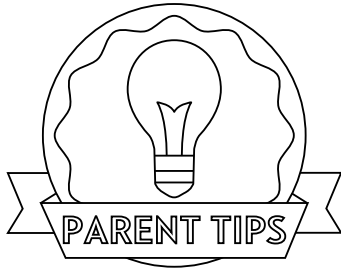

Kindergarten - Week 1

Ask your reader to put a finger on each dot as the letter name above is said. Make sure your child is always going from left to right. Developing these habits now will make learning to read an easier process.
